Dear Parents and Whanau Kia ora Koutou

These e-bulletins are sent out each Friday and intended to be a brief communication regarding what's happening at HPC.

- On Thursday 15 February 7 8pm we are holding an NCEA meeting in the college hall particularly for Year 11 parents who would like to understand more about how NCEA works. Students are welcome to attend with parents.
