> River Conferencing: River conferences (for parents, students and River Guides) will be held on Thursday 22nd March 4 - 8pm and Friday 23rd March 9 - 3pm. Parents will receive progress reports for each subject from the main office immediately prior to the meeting with your child's River Guide.

To make an appointment, either return the appointment notice which students have been issued with today or book online at www.schoolinterviews.co.nz (using the code 2gazw).

The purpose of River conferencing is to discuss with the River Guide each student's progress to date and goals for the year ahead. Each parent and student who attends will go in a draw for a chromebook.

Weekly subject notices: On Friday, each teacher is sending out brief summaries of what's happening in class and what students need to be reminded of. This will include notifications about new assignments that have been set by the teacher, homework tasks, new learning resources and missed deadlines for assignments.

Parents are able to opt in to receive weekly summaries, via email, on your child's Google Classroom activity. All parents/caregivers should have received an email inviting them to opt in to this service.
