Assessment Catch up day Friday, 22 June 2018: Students with incomplete work or assessments to complete will be required to attend school on catch up day. NCEA Fees and Financial Assistance: The NCEA entry fee is \$76.70 per year. This fee needs to be paid to the College by Wednesday, 5 September 2018. Late fees will incur a penalty of \$50.00 if not paid by 1 December 2018. Please note that this is an NZQA fee; the college collects it on behalf of NZQA. Financial assistance is available to qualifying families. Application forms are available at the Student Centre or by using the electronic Financial Assistance form and must be returned to the College by Thursday, 23 August 2018.

Bus meeting: For parents in the Franklin, Mangatawhiri, Hunua areas, there is a meeting at Mangatawhiri Primary School on Tuesday, 26 June 2018 at 6pm to discuss bus options for the future.

Free Health Clinic: Just a reminder that we have a free Doctor / Nurse Clinic on Tuesday mornings. All students are welcome to use this service even if they have their own doctor. Winter sports injuries, flu and strep throat are common concerns at the moment. Students may book an appointment via the Student Centre or Mr Henry (Guidance Counsellor).

If parents/caregivers/whānau have an existing dentist they want to stay with, we ask that when your child receives an appointment slip, to go to the mobile dental clinic and inform them that they will not be using their service.
