- NCEA Fees and Financial Assistance: The NCEA entry fee is \$76.70 per year. This fee needs to
  be paid to the College by Wednesday, 5 September 2018. Late fees will incur a penalty of \$50.00 if
  not paid by 1 December 2018. Please note that this is an NZQA fee; the college collects it on behalf
  of NZQA. Financial assistance is available to qualifying families. Application forms are available at

  College by Thursday, 23 August 2018.
