- Subject Selection Evening for Year 10s: Year 10 students will be given subject guides to help them select subjects for next year. The guide gives information about NCEA and Year 11 subjects (2019). An evening will be held for students on Thursday 18 October 7pm in the school hall, with careers staff and teachers available to answer any questions regarding subjects for next year.
