- Industrial Action: As the media has indicated teachers belonging to the NZEI and PPTA (primary
 and secondary teachers unions) have indicated that they will be taking industrial action on
 Wednesday, 29 May. The College will be closed for teaching on that day, but open for any students
 who require supervision students attending must be in full school uniform. Buses will not run on
 that day.

- NCEA Fees: The Minister of Education has announced that families of secondary students will no longer have to pay fees to enter NCEA and New Zealand Scholarship. This change will remove financial barriers and ensure all the credits received towards NCEA will be visible in a student's Record of Achievement. Any fees already paid have now been either credited to other fees or put into credit on your students account.
