- Senior Classes: For seniors, this semester concludes at the end of week 8 i.e. two weeks before the end of term. - HPC Tertiary Preparation Meeting: This evening is to be held on Tuesday, 7 May in the college hall and is to help caregivers understand and be better able to support students with their transition from school into tertiary study in 2020. The topics include University Entrance, scholarships, tertiary accommodation, course planning, Fees Free and Study Link (including student allowances).
- **Board Elections:** Nomination forms have now be mailed to all parents/caregivers on our roll. Nominations open on Friday, 10 May and close on Friday, 24 May. These can be returned to the Returning Officer at HPC by this date with a Candidate Statement.
- Summer/Winter Uniform Transition: The transition period for changing from summer to winter uniform expires at the end of next week. On Monday, 13 May all students are expected to be in correct winter uniform, i.e. standard black lace-up school shoes, long grey socks (boys), black stockings (girls) and regulation uniform jackets/jerseys.
