

Kia ora Parents and Whānau

Thank you for your patience as we try to come to grips with the guidelines around COVID Level 2 and how this impacts on our students and staff arrangements.

At Alert Level 2, it is deemed to be safe for all students and staff in the Waikato / Hauraki region to attend school.

For students who live in the **Auckland COVID area**, you will need to continue learning at home until Level 3 is lifted. If you haven't already done so, please contact the school so we can record the absence correctly.

If students from the Auckland COVID area need a **Chromebook** or hard copy of materials to be couriered out, please contact studentservices@haurakiplains.school.nz

Until we receive further clarification from the Ministry, for those students who live in the **Waikato / Hauraki area**, but have members of the household who are **continuing to work** in the Auckland area i.e. 'crossing the 'border', we need you to keep your child at home so as not to compromise the health and wellbeing of the wider school community in any way.

Students who were on the recent **ski trip**, may return to school.

Teachers will continue to provide work via **Google Classroom** in a weekly format for those students who need to learn from home. Work will be posted by Sunday evening.

If **students are unwell**, they should stay home (phone Healthline or your GP and get tested if a doctor or health professional recommends to do so).

Anyone who has been advised by health authorities to remain at home while they wait for COVID-19 tests results must stay home. Please let the school know if a member of the household is being **tested** for COVID-19.
