Rostering Home Arrangements

As signalled yesterday, we have a significant number of staff who have either reported in as a COVID positive case or who are isolating through being a household contact. If your child is rostered home, but you are not able to keep your child at home, please feel welcome to send them to school as usual. Those students will be supervised.

We are hoping that we are now at the peak of teacher absences and that no further rostering home will be necessary; however, we will keep parents informed with regular updates.
