COVID Update

Transition to Winter Uniform

• From Monday 4 April (Week 10) until Friday, 13 May (Term 2 Week 2), we will have a transition period from summer to winter uniform. This will give families almost 6 weeks to get their children's winter uniforms sorted out. During this time students may wear either summer or winter uniform, but not a combination of both, e.g. no scarf with sandals. By Monday, 16 May all students are expected to be in the correct winter uniform.

Winter Shoes

• The only acceptable winter school shoes, as indicated in our uniform requirements in the HPC Prospectus, are black leather lace-up school shoes with a heel of no more than 5 cm (as shown in the image). There are already a number of students wearing incorrect school shoes – those may be advertised in the shoe store as school shoes, but they are not acceptable under our policy. Please make sure your children are in the correct footwear (see image).
