Senior Academic Prize Giving was a great celebration of students' achievements. As was said to them on the night: "Your school is proud of you; your teachers and River Guides are proud of you and your parents and whanau are definitely proud of you. You have made yourselves proud."

Teacher Only Day Friday 11 November

Tomorrow (Friday) is a Teacher Only Day. This is a Ministry Accord day for schools to focus on how they will implement significant changes ahead to the school curriculum. Some of these changes include:

- Equity for Mātauranga Māori (i.e. Māori knowledge, values, perspectives, traditions) within all learning areas.
- The introduction and inclusion of new Aotearoa New Zealand's Histories content within the refreshed Social Sciences learning area.
- All learning areas at Years 9 and 10 at Junior level to be 'refreshed' both in terms of content including a Know, Understand and Do framework. Some of these refreshed learning areas contain controversial topics around gender and critical race theories.
- The introduction of literacy and numeracy external • assessments (exams) which will test the readiness of students for the workplace and further study. Without achieving the literacy and numeracy standards, students are unable to achieve any school qualifications.

While the Ministry has given two days in Term 4 for this work, we have kept this to just one day to avoid any unnecessary interruptions to students' learning and the school routine.

After some feedback regarding the cost of camp, the school has made the decision to pay for bus costs reducing the

cost of camp to \$150. This covers all accommodation, food and adventure activities which are run by qualified instructors at the camp.

A letter was given out this week with more information and let students know which two days they are at camp.

If in the first camp, students do not need to attend on Friday 9 December and if in the second group, they do not need to attend school on Wednesday 7 December before camp. This is because the vast majority of our staff are at either Year 9 or Year 10 camp that week.
