

## **New Attendance Notification System**

In support of the Government's Attendance and Engagement Strategy, we have started to use a new absence notification system. Students and their River Guides will get a daily notification of the previous two days' **Not in class** (?) absences, although any historical **Not in class** absences will also be listed. It is the responsibility of students to check in with their subject teachers and/or River Guides about those absences and to get it adjusted. Whānau/parents/caregivers will get a weekly notification of their children's absences. After 5 days of no explanation provided, **Not in class** (?) will be changed to **Truant/No Explanation** (T).
