A note about GPA

At prize giving our junior students were given their final overall Grade Point Average (GPA) for the year. This number will be different to what was shared in their Term 4 report. Students have earned 3 GPA's during the year, and we took the average of these three numbers, and weighted them according to the time period of each GPA calculation. For example the first GPA was across 18 weeks, the second GPA was across 6 weeks and the last GPA was across 12 weeks. The grade on students certificates at prize giving is their overall average for the year - and this was used to determine if they received their Certificate or Diploma with Achieved, Merit or Excellence.
