We have had two visits this week from our University of Waikato liaison, Andrew Gibbs, who presented first at assemblies and then to senior students. Andrew has a connection to our area, having played rugby for the Ngatea club, and working on a roller when the original turf was laid. Andrew shared with us that the University of Waikato gives out 11 million dollars worth of scholarships, is in the top 3 Universities in NZ, has a medical school opening in 2028, all law students who make the grade can progress, and there are nine different Engineering pathways on offer.

Congratulations to our Student Volunteer Army (SVA) ambassador Ruby McKay, who won the assembly quiz and scored herself a Waikato sweatshirt. Andrew was keen to remind students that evidence of community participation is one of the criteria that scholarship applicants need to meet.
