### When should you start exploring your career pathways?

I always say to students that, in my experience, there are two kinds of people; those who have decided what they want to be by the time they are five, and then there's the rest of us!

Whether students have a single idea, no idea or changeable ideas, we have tools to help. All students can log in to **Career Central** using their school email account. Follow these <u>instructions</u> to log in, find your profile, access resources and more. Career Central is the system that we use within school for careers interviews and pathways planning.

**Tahatū** is the NZ national careers database. Year 10 River groups have been exploring this with their River guides in Term 2. You don't have to have an account to use Tahatū but it helps to create one - using your school email - so that you can save interesting information for later on. Tahatū has over 4000+ careers, jobs and study pathways to explore. Follow these instructions to set up an account in Tahatū.

Earlier this week, some students attended the Tahatū careers expo in Hamilton to explore training, vocational pathways, study and career opportunities with providers from across the region.

### Inzone

Inzone is a career resource designed to provide individual careers information, guidance and support. The kiosk maintains a huge library of videos offering insights into many professions. These are arranged according to Vocational Pathways. Students can use the kiosk during a careers interview, or any time during the school day when they are free. The kiosk is located in the Careers Centre.
